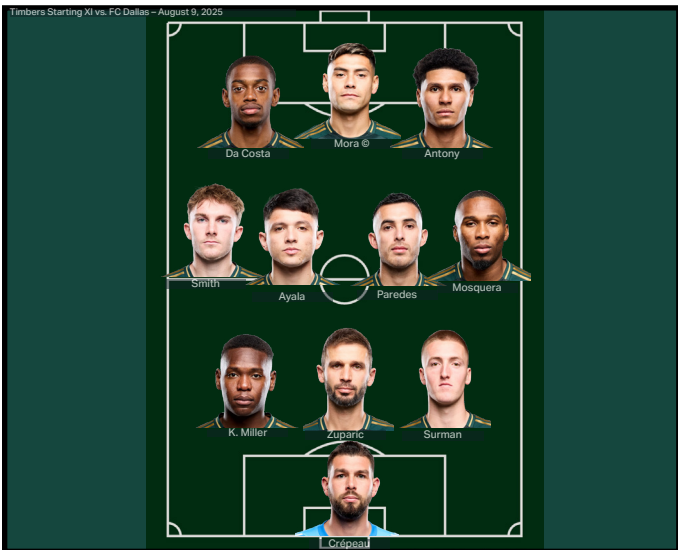

### GENERAL MANAGER NED GRABAVOY

Entering his ninth year with the club, Ned Grabavoy took the position of Portland Timbers General Manager ahead of the 2023 campaign.

Since Grabavoy joined the Timbers' technical staff in 2017, Portland has made six postseason runs (2024, 2021, 2020, 2019, 2018, 2017) and two MLS Cup appearances (2021, 2018), while claiming the MLS is Back title in 2020.

He previously served as the club's technical director (2019-22), overseeing all aspects of scouting, recruitment, and potential player acquisitions for the club in addition to roster management, construction, and player contract execution. After retiring from professional soccer in 2016, Grabavoy joined the technical staff in 2017 as the director of scouting and recruitment.

A veteran of MLS for 13 years, Grabavoy made 316 league appearances, winning two MLS Cups (2004, 2009) and a Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup title (2005), playing his final MLS season in 2016 with the Timbers.

The 14th overall pick in the 2004 MLS SuperDraft out of Indiana University, Grabavoy began his professional career with the LA Galaxy. He spent three seasons with the Galaxy (2004-06) before playing stints with Columbus Crew SC (2006-07), the San Jose Earthquakes (2008), Real Salt Lake (2009-14) and New York City FC (2016).

Ned and his wife Monica are parents to twins Charlotte and James.



### HEAD COACH PHIL NEVILLE

Entering his second season at the helm, the Portland Timbers named Phil Neville as their head coach in November of 2023. Neville's multiyear contract with the Timbers will see him in Portland through 2026. Neville, who holds a UEFA Pro License, is the fourth head coach in the club's MLS era.

In his first season with the Timbers, Neville led the club to a 12-11-11 record and to their first playoff berth since 2021. Notably, Portland set a new single-season club record with 65 goals scored last year.

Neville, 48, joins the club with six years of head coach experience at the senior level between his time in MLS and on the international stage, following a 19-year career as a distinguished player in England's Premier League and England Men's National Team. Most recently, Neville formed part of the Canadian Men's National Team technical staff as an assistant coach during the team's participation in the 2023 Concacaf Nations League Final and the 2023 Concacaf Gold Cup.

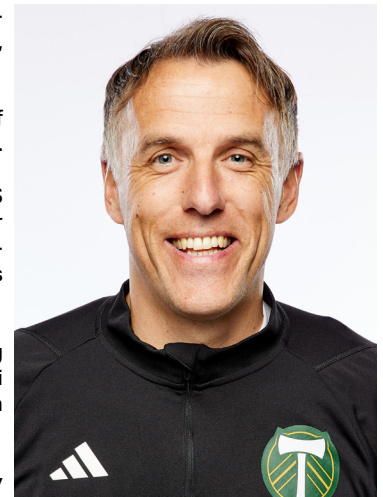
Neville was appointed as head coach of Inter Miami CF ahead of the club's second MLS season in 2021, leading them through two-plus MLS campaigns until his departure midway through 2023. In 2022, Neville and Miami finished sixth in the Eastern Conference standings with a mark of 14-14-6 (48 pts), earning a postseason berth and the team's best finish up until that point.

Prior to coaching in MLS, Neville was selected as the England Women's National Team head coach in January of 2018. At the helm of the Lionesses, Neville's side won the 2019 SheBelieves Cup and led the team to an undefeated 2019 FIFA Women's World Cup Qualification run before placing fourth in the tournament. Additionally, Neville had spells as an assistant coach for La Liga side Valencia CF (2015-16), Premier League side Manchester United (2013-14) and the England U21 Men's National Team (2012-13).

As a player, Neville enjoyed a stellar 19-year career as a defender at Manchester United and Everton FC. The England international made his professional debut with Manchester United in 1995. Playing with the Red Devils, Neville recorded 381 appearances in all competitions, helping the team win six Premier League championships, three FA Cups and one UEFA Champions League title. Notably, Neville and Manchester United won the treble (Champions League, FA Cup, Premier League) in the 1998-99 season. After playing 11 seasons at Manchester United under legendary manager Sir Alex Ferguson (1995-2005), Neville joined Everton FC in 2005 and went on to make 303 appearances in all competitions, captaining the team through eight seasons.

Internationally, Neville tallied 59 appearances for the England Men's National Team. He made five appearances in two different UEFA Euro tournaments (2000, 2004) and four appearances in FIFA World Cup Qualifiers (1998, 2001) with the Three Lions. Neville made his senior international debut against China on May 23, 1996. He also featured in England's U-16, U-18, and U-21 teams.

A native of Bury, England, Neville is married to Julie Neville, and is father to Harvey and Isabella Neville.

### TECHNICAL STAFF

#### TECHNICAL DIRECTOR JACK DODD

Formerly an assistant general manager of player personnel and scouting, Jack Dodd joined the Timbers staff in May of 2023 as the club's technical director following a nine-year tenure at Toronto FC (2014-2023).

Before joining TFC, Dodd spent six years as a business development manager at Scout7, where he created and developed a player and club data management and recruitment system. During that time, Dodd also served as a technical scout for Crystal Palace FC for a season (2013-2014) and an academy scout for Liverpool Football Club from 2008-2013.

Dodd earned his sports management degree at Coventry University in Coventry, England, in 2005.



#### ASSISTANT COACH DAVE VAN DEN BERGH

Hired ahead of the 2024 MLS season, Dave Van den Bergh brings 14 years of coaching experience between his time with the New England Revolution and the U.S. U-15, U-19 and U-20 Men's National Teams.

He joined the New England Revolution in 2019 and helped the team earn the MLS Shield during the 2021 season, tallying a league-record 73 points in one season (22-7-5).

Throughout his playing career, the Amsterdam, Netherlands, native played for Dutch side Ajax in 1995, Spain's Rayo Vallecano (1997-2000), FC Utrecht, MLS side Kansas City Wizards, the New York Red Bulls (2007-2008) and FC Dallas (2009). Van den Bergh earned two caps with the Netherlands Men's National Team in 2004.



#### ASSISTANT COACH LIAM RIDGEWELL

Liam Ridgewell, who holds his UEFA A Coaching License, begins his third season as part of the coaching staff in 2025. He joined the Timbers in 2014 as a Designated Player and spent five seasons with the club. During that time, Ridgewell made 110 MLS appearances (all starts) for Portland, helping guide the Timbers to three post-season appearances (2015, 2017, 2018) and winning MLS Cup in 2015.

The defender returned to England after 2018, making appearances for Hull City (2018-19) and Southend United (2019-20). Prior to joining the Timbers in 2014, Ridgewell spent 12 seasons in the English Premier League and the EFL Championship, recording over 200 appearances for Aston Villa, Birmingham City and West Bromwich Albion.



#### ASSISTANT COACH SHANNON MURRAY

Murray, who holds a USSF Pro license, is entering his 10th season with the club overall (2016-25), having spent time in various roles for the first team and T2. Notably, Murray took the helm of T2 in their first two seasons in MLS NEXT Pro (2022-23).

Before his time in Portland, Murray spent two seasons as an academy coach with Seattle Sounders FC.

A graduate of the University of Washington, Murray previously served as the technical director for Evergreen Soccer Club and the director of coaching education for Washington Youth Soccer.

Prior to beginning his career in coaching and education, Murray played six professional seasons in the A-League and Continental Indoor Soccer League.



#### GOALKEEPING COACH GUILLERMO "MEMO" VALENCIA

Guillermo "Memo" Valencia will begin his eighth season with the Timbers after joining the coaching staff in 2018. Valencia came to Portland after spending five seasons as the goalkeeper coach for the New York Cosmos, helping the team win three NASL Soccer Bowl championships.

Valencia, who holds a USSF goalkeeping and "A" licenses, has coached goalkeepers for the U.S. Men's National Team between the U-17 and U-23 levels since 2009. During his 11-year professional playing career as a goalkeeper in Colombia, Valencia played for America de Cali (1990-1995) and Deportivo Pereira (1995-2001), featuring as a key member of the Pereira side that won the Professional Colombian Soccer Association league championship. Valencia later moved to the United States to compete for the Westchester Flames and the Long Island Rough Riders.

### FINAL STRETCH

The Portland Timbers (10-8-7, 37pts) enter Matchday 29 in sixth place of the Western Conference, tied on points with fifth-place LAFC.

With nine matches to go before the end of the current campaign, Portland will travel for five matches and host four over the next two and a half months.

Following Saturday's match against Cincinnati, the Timbers have matches at San Diego (8/23), at Minnesota (8/30), vs NY Red Bulls (9/13), at Houston (9/20), at Vancouver (9/24), vs Dallas (9/27), at Seattle (10/4), and vs San Diego (10/18).

### TRANSACTION TRACKER

**August 14, 2025** - Portland Timbers sign Uruguayan international Felipe Carballo on loan for the remainder of the 2025 season as a Designated Player.

**August 13, 2025** - Portland Timbers sign Norwegian international Kristoffer Velde as Designated Player through 2028 with a club-option for 2029.

**August 12, 2025** - Portland Timbers transfer Santiago Moreno to Brazilian side Fluminense FC.

**August 7, 2025** - Portland Timbers acquire 2025 International Roster Slot from Toronto FC in exchange for \$175,000 in GAM.

**July 3, 2025** - Portland Timbers transfer Claudio Bravo to Argentinian side Argentinos Juniors.

**June 26, 2025** - Portland Timbers sign T2 forward Gage Guerra to one-year deal through the 2025 season with club options in 2026, 2027, and 2028.

**April 18, 2025** - Portland Timbers acquire midfielder Omir Fernandez through the 2026 season with a club option for 2027 from the Colorado Rapids in exchange for \$200,000 in 2025 General Allocation Money (GAM) and \$50,000 in conditional 2026 GAM.

**April 18, 2025** - Portland Timbers acquire \$270,000 in 2025 GAM from Inter Miami CF in exchange for a 2025 International Roster Slot.

**Feb. 17, 2025** - Portland Timbers sign David Da Costa through the 2028 season with a club option for 2029. Da Costa will occupy a Designated Player spot.

**Feb. 17, 2025** - Portland Timbers acquire a club-record \$12 million from FC Cincinnati in exchange for midfielder Evander.

**Feb. 4, 2025** - Portland Timbers acquire defender Jimer Fory through the 2028 season with a club option for 2029.

**Jan. 31, 2025** - Portland Timbers sign defender Ian Smith to a one-year contract with three club option years through 2028.

**Jan. 24, 2025** - Portland Timbers acquire \$200,000 in 2025 GAM from Inter Miami CF in exchange for a 2025 International Roster Slot.

**Jan. 22, 2025** - Portland Timbers sign forward Kevin Kelsy through 2028 season with a club option for 2029. Portland acquired Kelsy from Ukrainian top-flight side Shakhtar Donetsk for a transfer fee after trading \$75,000 in 2025 General Allocation Money (GAM) to FC Cincinnati in exchange for his Right of First Refusal.

**Jan. 15, 2025** - Portland Timbers acquire midfielder Joao Ortiz through the 2027 season with a club option for 2028.

**Jan. 15, 2025** - Portland Timbers acquire \$100,000 in 2025 General Allocation Money (GAM) from Charlotte FC in exchange for midfielder Eryk Williamson. The Timbers could receive up to \$350,000 in GAM if certain performance metrics are reached.

**Dec. 23, 2024** - Portland Timbers sign free agent winger Ariel Lassiter through the 2026 season with a club option for 2027.

### TIMBERS VS. FC CINCINNATI HISTORY

Portland and FC Cincinnati will face off for just the third time in MLS regular season history, and for the first time in the Rose City. The Timbers hold a record of 0-2-0 in their two meetings with Cincinnati. The two sides last met on April 22, 2023 at TQL Stadium where the Timbers fell 2-1 to the hosts.

The Timbers are set to face former Portland player Evander for the first time. Portland acquired a club-record \$12 million from FC Cincinnati in February for Evander. Timbers forward Kevin Kelsy is also set to face his former team, Cincinnati, for the first time.

### NEW DPs IN TOWN

The Portland Timbers unveiled two new Designated Player signings this week; Felipe Carballo and Kristoffer Velde.

Carballo was acquired on loan from Brazilian Serie A side Grêmio for the remainder of the 2025 season. He spent the last two seasons with the Eastern Conference's New York Red Bulls, helping them reach MLS Cup 2024.

Velde was acquired from top-tier Greek side Olympiacos where he won the 2024-2025 Super Ligue 1 Championship and the 2024-2025 Greek Cup. Velde is signed through the 2028 season with a club option for 2029.

### PROVIDENCE PARK

This season, The Timbers are 8-2-5 at Providence Park with 24 goals scored across all competitions in 2025.

Home to the Portland Timbers, Providence Park seats a capacity of 25,218, the fifth largest capacity of soccer-specific stadiums in the country. Formerly named Jeld-Wen Field, PGE Park, Civic Stadium and originally named Multnomah Stadium in 1926 when construction was completed, Providence Park is currently the oldest soccer-specific stadium in Major League Soccer.

The Timbers are 131-49-66 all-time at Providence Park in MLS play, scoring 442 goals at their home stadium. Portland has won double-digit home games five times (2013, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2021), with its best season coming in 2016 in which the club finished 12-3-2 at home.

### DIEGO CHARA, THE LIVING LEGEND

Club captain Diego Chara started in his 398th MLS regular season match on July 16 against Real Salt Lake. With two more starts, he is set to become the fifth field player in MLS history and one of two active field players currently to reach 400 starts in MLS. Notably, Chara would be the first field player to accomplish this feat with a single club.

In 15 seasons with the Timbers, Chara has logged 419 regular season appearances (398 starts), 12 goals and 35 assists. A legend of the club, the Colombian native was named to the Timbers' fan-voted All Time XI in honor of the club's 50th season anniversary. Chara is the only Timbers All-Time XI selection that is both still active and playing for the club.

### 50TH ANNIVERSARY SEASON

The Portland Timbers are celebrating their 50th anniversary in 2025. To commemorate the occasion, the club celebrated the first-ever team from 1975 on June 13, the 10th anniversary of 2015 MLS Cup on July 16, the All-Time Timbers XI and 50th anniversary celebration on July 19, and will end with the final celebration night; club captain Diego Chara Bobblehead Night on August 16.

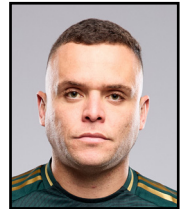

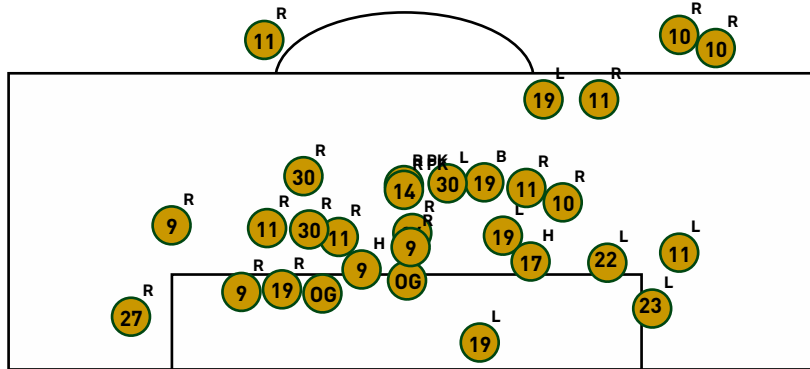
