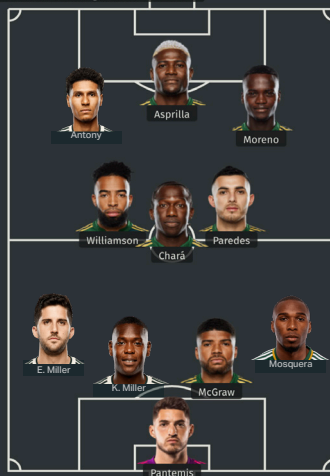

### GENERAL MANAGER NED GRABAVOY

Ned Grabavoy was named Portland Timbers general manager on Jan. 11, 2023, beginning his eighth year with the club. He is the second general manager in the Timbers MLS era.

Since Grabavoy joined the Timbers' technical staff in 2017, Portland has made five postseason runs (2021, 2020, 2019, 2018, 2017) and two MLS Cup appearances (2021, 2018), while claiming the MLS is Back title in 2020.

He previously served as the club's technical director (2019-22), overseeing all aspects of scouting, recruitment, and potential player acquisitions for the club in addition to roster management, construction, and player contract execution. After retiring from professional soccer in 2016, Grabavoy joined the technical staff in 2017 as the director of scouting and recruitment.

A veteran of MLS for 13 years, Grabavoy made 316 league appearances, winning two MLS Cups (2004, 2009) and a Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup title (2005), playing his final MLS season in 2016 with the Timbers.

The 14th overall pick in the 2004 MLS SuperDraft out of Indiana University, Grabavoy began his professional career with the LA Galaxy. He spent three seasons with the Galaxy (2004-06) before playing stints with Columbus Crew SC (2006-07), the San Jose Earthquakes (2008), Real Salt Lake (2009-14) and New York City FC (2016).

Ned and his wife Monica are parents to twins Charlotte and James.



### HEAD COACH PHIL NEVILLE

The Portland Timbers named Phil Neville as their head coach in November of 2023. Neville's multiyear contract with the Timbers will see him in Portland through 2026. Neville, who holds a UEFA Pro License, becomes the fourth head coach in the club's MLS era.

Neville, 46, joins the club with six years of head coach experience at the senior level between his time in MLS and on the international stage, following a 19-year career as a distinguished player in England's Premier League and England Men's National Team. Most recently, Neville formed part of the Canadian Men's National Team technical staff as an assistant coach during the team's participation in the 2023 Concacaf Nations League Final and the 2023 Concacaf Gold Cup.

Neville was appointed as head coach of Inter Miami CF ahead of the club's second MLS season in 2021, leading them through two-plus MLS campaigns until his departure midway through 2023. In 2022, Neville and Miami finished sixth in the Eastern Conference standings with a mark of 14-14-6 (48 pts), earning a postseason berth and the team's best finish to date.

Prior to coaching in MLS, Neville was selected as the England Women's National Team head coach in January of 2018. At the helm of the Lionesses, Neville's side won the 2019 SheBelieves Cup and led the team to an undefeated 2019 FIFA Women's World Cup Qualification run before placing fourth in the tournament. Additionally, Neville had spells as an assistant coach for La Liga side Valencia CF (2015-16), Premier League side Manchester United (2013-14) and the England U21 Men's National Team (2012-13).

As a player, Neville enjoyed a stellar 19-year career as a defender at Manchester United and Everton FC. The England international made his professional debut with Manchester United in 1995. Playing with the Red Devils, Neville recorded 381 appearances in all competitions, helping the team win six Premier League championships, three FA Cups and one UEFA Champions League title. Notably, Neville and Manchester United won the treble (Champions League, FA Cup, Premier League) in the 1998-99 season. After playing 11 seasons at Manchester United under legendary manager Sir Alex Ferguson (1995-2005), Neville joined Everton FC in 2005 and went on to make 303 appearances in all competitions, captaining the team through eight seasons.

Internationally, Neville tallied 59 appearances for the England Men's National Team. He made five appearances in two different UEFA Euro tournaments (2000, 2004) and four appearances in FIFA World Cup Qualifiers (1998, 2001) with the Three Lions. Neville made his senior international debut against China on May 23, 1996. He also featured in England's U-16, U-18, and U-21 teams.

A native of Bury, England, Neville is married to Julie Neville, and is father to Harvey and Isabella Neville.

### TECHNICAL STAFF

#### TECHNICAL DIRECTOR JACK DODD

Formerly an assistant general manager of player personnel and scouting, Jack Dodd joined the Timbers staff in May of 2023 as the club's technical director following a nine-year tenure at Toronto FC (2014-2023).

Before joining TFC, Dodd spent six years as a business development manager at Scout7, where he created and developed a player and club data management and recruitment system.

During that time, Dodd also served as a technical scout for Crystal Palace FC for a season (2013-2014) and an academy scout for Liverpool Football Club from 2008-2013.

Dodd earned his sports management degree at Coventry University in Coventry, England, in 2005.



#### ASSISTANT COACH DAVE VAN DEN BERGH

Hired ahead of the 2024 MLS season, Dave Van den Bergh brings 13 years of coaching experience between his time with the New England Revolution and the U.S. U-15, U-19 and U-20 Men's National Teams.

He joined the New England Revolution in 2019 and helped the team earn the MLS Shield during the 2021 season, tallying a league-record 73 points in one season (22-7-5).

Throughout his playing career, the Amsterdam, Netherlands, native played for Dutch side Ajax in 1995, Spain's Rayo Vallecano (1997-2000), FC Utrecht, MLS side Kansas City Wizards, the New York Red Bulls (2007-2008) and FC Dallas (2009). Van den Bergh earned two caps with the Netherlands Men's National Team in 2004.



#### ASSISTANT COACH LIAM RIDGEWELL

Liam Ridgewell, who holds his UEFA B Coaching License, begins his second season as part of the coaching staff in 2024. He joined the Timbers in 2014 as a Designated Player and spent five seasons with the club. During that time, Ridgewell made 110 MLS appearances (all starts) for Portland, helping guide the Timbers to three post-season appearances (2015, 2017, 2018) and winning MLS Cup in 2015.

The defender returned to England after 2018, making appearances for Hull City (2018-19) and Southend United (2019-20). Prior to joining the Timbers in 2014, Ridgewell spent 12 seasons in the English Premier League and the EFL Championship, recording over 200 appearances for Aston Villa, Birmingham City and West Bromwich Albion.



#### ASSISTANT COACH SHANNON MURRAY

Murray, who holds a USSF Pro license, is entering his ninth season with the club overall (2016-24), having spent time in various roles for the first team and T2. Notably, Murray took the helm of T2 in their first two seasons in MLS NEXT Pro (2022-23).

Before his time in Portland, Murray spent two seasons as an academy coach with Seattle Sounders FC.

A graduate of the University of Washington, Murray previously served as the technical director for Evergreen Soccer Club and the director of coaching education for Washington Youth Soccer.

Prior to beginning his career in coaching and education, Murray played six professional seasons in the A-League and Continental Indoor Soccer League.



#### GOALKEEPING COACH GUILLERMO "MEMO" VALENCIA

Guillermo "Memo" Valencia will begin his seventh season with the Timbers after joining the coaching staff in 2018. Valencia came to Portland after spending five seasons as the goalkeeper coach for the New York Cosmos, helping the team win three NASL Soccer Bowl championships.

Valencia, who holds a USSF goalkeeping and "A" licenses, has coached goalkeepers for the U.S. Men's National Team between the U-17 and U-23 levels since 2009. During his 11-year professional playing career as a goalkeeper in Colombia, Valencia played for America de Cali (1990-1995) and Deportivo Pereira (1995-2001), featuring as a key member of the Pereira side that won the Professional Colombian Soccer Association league championship. Valencia later moved to the United States to compete for the Westchester Flames and the Long Island Rough Riders.

### LAST MATCH AGAINST D.C. UNITED

**PORTLAND, Ore.** – The Portland Timbers conceded a first-half goal and were unable to rally, falling 1-0 to D.C. United in front of 25,218 fans at Providence Park on Sept. 15, 2019.

**Notes:**

The Timbers finished the match with 523 completed passes, which is the second-most in team history in the MLS era behind only their match against the Chicago Fire on Aug. 15, 2019.

Portland held 67.3 percent of the possession in the match, which is the highest possession percentage the Timbers have had in a match this season and tied for the third-highest since the club joined MLS in 2011.

Diego Valeri became the third Timbers player during the MLS era to make 200 starts in league play with his start against D.C. United.

Jeremy Ebobisse played in his 47th consecutive match in all competitions, which is the third-longest active streak among all MLS field players.

Marvin Loria created four chances in the match, which is the most chances he has created in a match in his MLS career.

In 10 all-time MLS regular season meetings, the Portland Timbers and D.C. United have an even record of 4-4-2. The Timbers have the edge when hosting D.C., earning a mark of 3-2-1 at Providence Park. The two sides will face off on Saturday for the first time since 2019, when D.C. cinched a 1-0 win against the home side in Portland on September 15.

### YEAR 14

Entering their 14th MLS season, the Timbers are one of 16 active teams that've been in the league since 2011 (Colorado, D.C., Dallas, New England, Philadelphia, Salt Lake, Seattle, Chicago, Columbus, Houston, LA Galaxy, NYRB, San Jose, Sporting KC, Vancouver). Portland has played 432 regular-season matches to date, posting a winning record of 167-145-120. Since joining MLS, the Timbers have made seven postseason appearances, including five of the last seven seasons (2017-21). Three of those playoff runs have resulted in Western Conference Championships and MLS Cup appearances, claiming their first title win in 2015. Diego Chara is the only player on the active Portland roster that has been with the club since its inaugural season in 2011, leading the Timbers in all-time appearances (368) for the Green and Gold.

### GOAL SCORERS AND PLAYMAKERS

In his first appearance since returning from an ACL injury in the 2023 season, Eryk Williamson scored Portland's first goal of the season in the season opener against Colorado on Feb. 24. It marked Williamson's fifth career MLS goal and first since May 1, 2021. Also tallying an assist in the match, Williamson logged the third multi-goal contribution performance of his career and earned himself Team of the Matchday 1+2 bench honors. Also in the Feb. 24 match against Colorado, Antony recorded his first career brace, earning himself Team of the Matchday 1+2 recognition. It marked the 56th brace in club history. Juan Mosquera and Cristhian Paredes also tallied assists in the match. It marked Paredes' 15th career regular season assist for the Timbers, and the seventh of Mosquera's.

### THE GODFATHER

The most tenured player on the Timbers roster, Diego Chara is in his 14th MLS season. He leads the club in games played (368), games started (362) and minutes played (32,296). Notably, Chara ranks second all-time amongst MLS players in games started with one club and minutes played for one club, trailing only Nick Rimando in each of those categories. With his next appearance, Chara will tie Rimando for second most games played all time with one club. All time in MLS, Chara ranks 19th in games played, 12th in games started and 12th in minutes played. Of active field players in the league, Chara ranks third most in games started, trailing only Darlington Nagbe and Dax McCarty.

### PRESEASON REPORT

Participating in the Coachella Valley Invitational for a second consecutive preseason, the Timbers played matches against NYCFC, San Jose Earthquakes and Chicago Fire FC in Indio, Calif. at the Empire Polo Fields. The team opened the tournament on Feb. 10 with a 1-1 draw against NYCFC. While NYCFC's lone goal was a penalty kick, Felipe Mora tallied the game-tying goal in the run of play, assisted by Santiago Moreno. In their second match of the Invitational, Portland dropped a 1-0 result to San Jose on Feb. 14, conceding only a penalty kick goal once again. The Timbers closed out the tournament with a 2-1 loss to the Chicago Fire on Feb. 17 despite striking first with a goal from Dairon Asprilla, assisted by Evander, in the seventh minute of the match. Maxime Crépeau, James Pantemis and Kamal Miller each made their first appearances in Green and Gold throughout the tournament. Pudis in consequias dolorem olupta quis dolora

### COACH OF THE MATCHDAY

After winning his first match at the helm for Portland, head coach Phil Neville was awarded Coach of the Matchday (1+2) for leading his team to a 4-1 win over Colorado, becoming the first head coach in club history to win their first match. The Timbers named Neville as their head coach in November of 2023. Neville's multiyear contract with the Timbers will see him in Portland through 2026. He holds a UEFA Pro License and becomes the fourth head coach in the club's MLS era. The 46-year-old boss joins the club with six years of head coach experience at the senior level between his time with Inter Miami (2021-23) and the England Women's National Team (2018-21). As a player, Neville enjoyed a stellar 19-year career as a defender at Manchester United and Everton FC. Internationally, Neville tallied 59 appearances for the England Men's National Team.

### SETTING THE STANDARD

Opening their season with a 4-1 win over Colorado on Feb. 24, The Timbers scored the most goals of any team in MLS through the first week of play. It marked the second-most goals scored by the Timbers in a season opener after Portland scored five against Minnesota United in 2017. It was also just the second MLS match in which the Timbers have scored four first-half goals in, the first being against the Seattle Sounders on August 28, 2016.

### GREEN AND GOLD DNA

Of Portland's 25-man roster, 21 of those players are returning from the previous season to the Green and Gold. Notably, Santiago Moreno and Juan David Mosquera both signed contract extensions with the club over the offseason, with Moreno's seeing him through 2026 with a 2027 option and Mosquera's being through 2027 with a 2028 option. Additionally, Portland signed free agent Eric Miller to a new contract with the club through the 2025 season.

### CANADIAN ACQUISITIONS

Portland signed a trio of Canadian internationals during the offseason in defender, Kamal Miller and goalkeepers James Pantemis and Maxime Crépeau.

In exchange for \$500,000 in 2024 GAM, \$125,000 in 2025 GAM and a 2024 international roster spot to Miami, Miller is under contract with the Timbers through 2026 with a club option in 2027. The 26-year-old defender made his Timbers debut in the season opener against Colorado, playing 90 minutes. A 2022 MLS All Star, Miller spent the last five seasons playing in MLS for Orlando City (2019-20), CF Montreal (2020-23), and Inter Miami (2023). Internationally, Miller has made 41 appearances (37 starts) for the Canadian Men's National Team and was on their 2022 World Cup roster.

Pantemis, 26, made his Timbers debut in the season opener against Colorado, earning his first win with the club. The free agent joined Portland after spending six seasons with CF Montreal (2018-2023). Pantemis logged seven clean sheets in 34 regular-season appearances (34 starts) for Montreal, helping them claim the Eastern Conference's second seed of the 2022 Audi MLS Cup playoffs. Notably, Pantemis was named to the Canadian Men's National Team roster for the 2022 FIFA World Cup.

Crépeau, 29, signed a two year contract with a 2026 option with Portland. In 12 seasons, he has logged 100 regular season appearances (all starts), recording 23 clean sheets and a winning mark of 42-35-23 across competitions with LAFC (2022-2023), Vancouver Whitecaps FC (2019-2021) and the Montreal Impact (2013-2017). In the last two seasons for LAFC, Crépeau made back-to-back MLS Cup appearances and claimed the 2022 title. Internationally, Crépeau has made 15 appearances (14 starts) for the Canadian Men's National Team. Crépeau helped Canada qualify for the team's second all-time World Cup appearance in 2022 before missing the World Cup due to an injury on Nov. 11, 2022.
