TEAM NOTES VS. PORTLAND

Last Time We Met

The San Jose Earthquakes fell to the Portland Timbers 2-1 on the road at Providence Park in Portland, Ore. Forward Matthew Hoppe made his first MLS start and scored his first goal for San Jose while forward Cade Cowell became the youngest player in MLS history to earn 100 MLS appearances.

Against Portland

The Quakes are 6-17-10 against Portland, holding a 0-13-4 record on the road. The Quakes are still searching for their first victory at Providence Park in 33 games dating back to 2011.

Comeback Kings

The Earthquakes came back from an early two-goal deficit to defeat the Colorado Rapids 3-2 on Saturday. The last time San Jose came back from a 2-0 road deficit to win was San Jose Earthquakes against the LA Galaxy on May 23, 2012 (3-2). The Quakes would go on to capture the Supporters' Shield that season.

Defensive Strength

The Quakes' defense has conceded just four goals in three games since the return of center back Bruno Wilson to the lineup after conceding 22 in their first nine contests.

MLS Team of the Matchday

San Jose Earthquakes defender Vítor Costa and forward Cristian Espinoza have been named to Major League Soccer's Team of the Matchday for Matchday 13. Costa had two assists, while Espinoza had an assist and the game-winning goal.

Offensive Firepower

Cristian Espinoza notched a goal and an assist against the Colorado Rapids on Saturday, marking his 65th career assist and 13th career game-winning goal with the Quakes. Espinoza now ranks second for most assists this season (8), trailing only Lionel Messi of Inter Miami CF (12).

Forward Amahl Pellegrino scored his second goal in as many games to run his total to three on the campaign, while left back Vítor Costa amassed his first and second MLS assists.

First of Many

New Quakes Designated Player Hernán López made his first MLS start and scored his first MLS goal on Saturday vs. Colorado after appearing in the starting 11 on Tuesday in the club's 1-0 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup Round of 32 win over Oakland Roots SC. The attacking midfielder joined San Jose for a club-record transfer fee last month. Since his signing, the Quakes have gone undefeated across all competitions (3-0-1).

- Cristian Espinoza sits at fifth for most goals in club history (30). He ranks one goal behind Jeremy Ebobisse and two goals away from tying Landon Donovan for third most goals (32).
- Cristian Espinoza is now tied with Richard Mulrooney and Shea Salinas for the most game-winning assists in club history (14).

COACHING STAFF BIOS

Luchi Gonzalez - Head Coach

Luchi Gonzalez enters his second season as head coach since signing on Aug. 17, 2022. In his initial campaign, he led the Earthquakes to their first playoff berth since 2020. Gonzalez previously served as an assistant coach for the United States Men's National Team during the 2022 FIFA World Cup.

Gonzalez, 43, was named FC Dallas' head coach ahead of the 2019 season and led the club to back-to-back MLS Cup Playoff appearances in 2019 and 2020. Over those two seasons, FC Dallas lost just one of 27 home matches (17-1-9) and ranked in the top seven defensively both years. Gonzalez served as Director of the FC Dallas Academy from 2012-18 and helped guide the most successful youth program in the United States. In his six years with the FC Dallas Academy, the club won four U.S. Soccer Development Academy National Championships and the 2016 Dallas Cup Super Group (U19).



Ian Russell - Assistant Coach

Ian Russell returns to San Jose as an assistant coach. Russell made 134 appearances in MLS between 2000-07, including 131 for San Jose between 2000-05, helping the Earthquakes win MLS Cup championships in 2001 and 2003 and a Supporters' Shield in 2005. The Seattle native then served as an assistant coach for the Quakes from 2008-16, which included a second Supporters' Shield in 2012. Russell was named head coach of the Earthquakes' then-USL affiliate Reno 1868 FC ahead of their inaugural season in 2017 and spent four years at the helm with Reno. Russell most recently served as an assistant coach with Toronto FC in 2021.



Steve Ralston - Assistant Coach

Steve Ralston originally joined the Earthquakes as an assistant coach in 2015 after four years in the same capacity with Houston Dynamo FC. He took over as interim head coach of the Quakes for the final six games of 2018. After three years away, he returned to San Jose as an interim assistant coach in 2022. A native of St. Louis, Ralston retired from Major League Soccer in 2010 as the league's all-time leader in assists (135), games played (378), starts (372), and minutes (33,143). He played in four MLS Cup finals for New England and was named an MLS All-Star seven times. He received MLS Best XI recognition three times during his 15-year playing career.



Luciano Fusco - Assistant Coach

Luciano Fusco is in his third season with San Jose as an assistant coach after assisting under interim head coach Alex Covelo during the final 27 matches of the 2022 season. He previously held roles as an assistant coach with Quakes II in MLS NEXT Pro and as a head coach in the Quakes Academy. Prior to joining the Earthquakes in 2018, Fusco served as a head coach in the LAFC Academy and as an assistant coach for UCLA men's soccer team from 2016-2018, where he worked with future Quakes and U.S. National Team midfielder Jackson Yueill. He also earned four coaching invites with the U.S. U-16 National Team.



Adin Brown - Goalkeeper Coach

Adin Brown returns to the Earthquakes as goalkeeper coach. Brown most recently served as goalkeeper coach for Chicago Fire FC (2020-22). Prior to joining Chicago, Brown was goalkeeper coach for the Portland Timbers (2015-17) and Timbers2 (2018-19), helping the club win its first MLS Cup in 2015. He was also goalkeeper coach for the University of Portland men's soccer team from 2013-15. Brown, a native of Pleasant Hill, California, and graduate of De La Salle High School, attended the College of William and Mary and was just the third goalkeeper in NCAA history to be named a First-Team All-American twice. He was also the United States' starting keeper throughout qualification for the 2000 Summer Olympics but missed the final competition due to injury.

QUOTABLE VS. COLORADO

EARTHQUAKES HEAD COACH LUCHI GONZALEZ

On coming back from two goals down to win:

"Credit to the guys themselves. They're on the field. I'm on the sideline. They themselves found a way to change the flow, change the rhythm, being down 2-0 and finding a way to respond and keep believing. They pushed and tied it up before half. The first 15, 20 minutes, I thought we created some good chances, but they're at home. They're a confident team getting results home and away. They're aggressive pressing, they're aggressive breaking the last line, and they're aggressive in set pieces. They took it to us after the first 15, 20 minutes. Things bounced our way with some of the VAR calls. It allowed us to recharge and get back into the focus of the game.

"At half, we're coming in saying, 'Good response, but that's not good enough.' We needed to be better individually and collectively, in our defensive blocks. Defend give-and-gos, defend combinations, win more duels, be more controlled and composed. Stop giving away set pieces in and around our box. We got on the same page collectively, and then from that I think we were effective offensively with the ball in transition breaking their last line."

EARTHQUAKES FORWARD CRISTIAN ESPINOZA

On preparation leading to tonight's game:

"We've been working very hard during the week. Those kind of situations in the corner attack we used to practice very often. ... When you practice every day, a different kind of situation of the game, when you have to do it in the weekend, it's very simple. I think today was a big response of the team. After all of the difficulties that we had before the game and during the game, we are really happy."

EARTHQUAKES DEFENDER VÍTOR COSTA

On winning three games in eight days:

"I think the team has worked hard for weeks to get these results. Three games in a week is very hard; it's not enough time. But our team showed strength and were motivated to win these games. Credit to everyone and the staff."

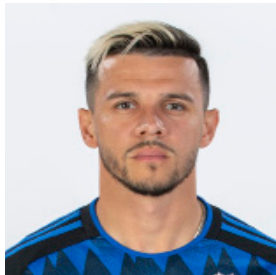

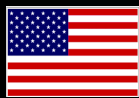
