## GENERAL MANAGER NED GRABAVOY



Entering his tenth year with the club, Ned Grabavoy took the position of Portland Timbers General Manager ahead of the 2023 campaign.

Since Grabavoy joined the Timbers' technical staff in 2017, Portland has made seven postseason runs (2025, 2024, 2021, 2020, 2019, 2018, 2017) and two MLS Cup appearances (2021, 2018), while claiming the MLS is Back title in 2020. Notably, the Timbers have made consecutive playoff appearances in two of Grabavoy's three years as General Manager.

He previously served as the club's technical director (2019-22), overseeing all aspects of scouting, recruitment, and potential player acquisitions for the club in addition to roster management, construction, and player contract execution. After retiring from professional soccer in 2016, Grabavoy joined the technical staff in 2017 as the director of scouting and recruitment.

A veteran of MLS for 13 years, Grabavoy made 316 league appearances, winning two MLS Cups (2004, 2009) and a Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup title (2005), playing his final MLS season in 2016 with the Timbers.

The 14th overall pick in the 2004 MLS SuperDraft out of Indiana University, Grabavoy began his professional career with the LA Galaxy. He spent three seasons with the Galaxy (2004-06) before playing stints with Columbus Crew SC (2006-07), the San Jose Earthquakes (2008), Real Salt Lake (2009-14) and New York City FC (2016).

Ned and his wife Monica are parents to twins Charlotte and James.

## HEAD COACH PHIL NEVILLE



Entering his third season in charge, the Portland Timbers named Phil Neville as their head coach in November of 2023. Neville's multiyear contract with the Timbers will see him in Portland through the end of the 2026 season. Neville, who holds a UEFA Pro License, is the fourth head coach in the club's MLS era.

In his second year at the helm, the former England international led the Timbers to their second-straight playoff qualification with an 11-12-11 record in 2025. In the postseason, Portland defeated Real Salt Lake in the Wild Card round before falling in the third game of the Round One series to top-seeded San Diego FC.

In his first season with the Timbers, Neville led the club to a 12-11-11 record and their first playoff berth since 2021. Notably, in 2024, Portland set a new single-season club scoring record with 65 goals netted under Neville.

Neville, 49, joined the club with six years of prior head coaching experience at the senior level between his time in MLS and on the international stage, following a 19-year career as a distinguished player in England's Premier League and England Men's National Team. Most recently, Neville formed part of the Canadian Men's National Team technical staff as an assistant coach during the team's participation in the 2023 Concacaf Nations League Final and the 2023 Concacaf Gold Cup.

Neville was appointed as head coach of Inter Miami CF ahead of the club's second MLS season in 2021. He led the Herons from 2021-2023.

Prior to coaching in MLS, Neville was selected as the England Women's National Team head coach in January of 2018. At the helm of the Lionesses, Neville's side won the 2019 SheBelieves Cup and led the team to an undefeated 2019 FIFA Women's World Cup Qualification run before placing fourth in the tournament. Additionally, Neville had spells as an assistant coach for La Liga side Valencia CF (2015-16), Premier League side Manchester United (2013-14) and the England U21 Men's National Team (2012-13).

As a player, Neville enjoyed a stellar 19-year career as a defender at Manchester United and Everton FC. The England international made his professional debut with Manchester United in 1995. Playing with the Red Devils, Neville recorded 381 appearances in all competitions, helping the team win six Premier League championships, three FA Cups and one UEFA Champions League title. Notably, Neville and Manchester United won the treble (Champions League, FA Cup, Premier League) in the 1998-99 season. After playing 11 seasons at Manchester United under legendary manager Sir Alex Ferguson (1995-2005), Neville joined Everton FC in 2005 and went on to make 303 appearances in all competitions, captaining the team through eight seasons.

Internationally, Neville tallied 59 appearances for the England Men's National Team. He made five appearances in two different UEFA Euro tournaments (2000, 2004) and four appearances in FIFA World Cup Qualifiers (1998, 2001) with the Three Lions. Neville made his senior international debut against China on May 23, 1996. He also featured in England's U-16, U-18, and U-21 teams.

A native of Bury, England, Neville is married to Julie Neville, and is father to Harvey and Isabella Neville.

### TECHNICAL STAFF

#### TECHNICAL DIRECTOR JACK DODD

Formerly an assistant general manager of player personnel and scouting, Jack Dodd joined the Timbers staff in May of 2023 as the club's technical director following a nine-year tenure at Toronto FC (2014-2023).

Before joining TFC, Dodd spent six years as a business development manager at Scout7, where he created and developed a player and club data management and recruitment system. During that time, Dodd also served as a technical scout for Crystal Palace FC for a season (2013-2014) and an academy scout for Liverpool Football Club from 2008-2013.

Dodd earned his sports management degree at Coventry University in Coventry, England, in 2005.



#### ASSISTANT COACH DAVE VAN DEN BERGH

Hired ahead of the 2024 MLS season, Dave Van den Bergh brings 14 years of coaching experience between his time with the New England Revolution and the U.S. U-15, U-19 and U-20 Men's National Teams.

He joined the New England Revolution in 2019 and helped the team earn the MLS Shield during the 2021 season, tallying a league-record 73 points in one season (22-7-5).

Throughout his playing career, the Amsterdam, Netherlands, native played for Dutch side Ajax in 1995, Spain's Rayo Vallecano (1997-2000), FC Utrecht, MLS side Kansas City Wizards, the New York Red Bulls (2007-2008) and FC Dallas (2009). Van den Bergh earned two caps with the Netherlands Men's National Team in 2004.



#### ASSISTANT COACH LIAM RIDGEWELL

Liam Ridgewell, who holds his UEFA A Coaching License, begins his fourth season as part of the coaching staff in 2026. He joined the Timbers in 2014 as a Designated Player and spent five seasons with the club. During that time, Ridgewell made 110 MLS appearances (all starts) for Portland, helping guide the Timbers to three postseason appearances (2015, 2017, 2018) and winning MLS Cup in 2015.

The defender returned to England after 2018, making appearances for Hull City (2018-19) and Southend United (2019-20). Prior to joining the Timbers in 2014, Ridgewell spent 12 seasons in the English Premier League and the EFL Championship, recording over 200 appearances for Aston Villa, Birmingham City and West Bromwich Albion.



#### ASSISTANT COACH SHANNON MURRAY

Murray, who holds a USSF Pro license, is entering his 11th season with the club overall (2016-26), having spent time in various roles for the first team and T2. Notably, Murray took the helm of T2 in their first two seasons in MLS NEXT Pro (2022-23).

Before his time in Portland, Murray spent two seasons as an academy coach with Seattle Sounders FC.

A graduate of the University of Washington, Murray previously served as the technical director for Evergreen Soccer Club and the director of coaching education for Washington Youth Soccer.

Prior to beginning his career in coaching and education, Murray played six professional seasons in the A-League and Continental Indoor Soccer League.



#### ASSISTANT COACH ALEX DODGSHON

New to Portland's coaching staff in 2026, Dodgshon served as an assistant on Toronto FC's technical staff from 2023 to 2025, where he focused on scouting and analytics.

Before his time with TFC, Dodgshon spent over two years with Canada Soccer as the lead analyst for the Canadian Men's National Team. During this period, he supported the team through multiple Concacaf Gold Cups (2021, 2023), the 2022-23 Concacaf Nations League, and the FIFA World Cup Qatar 2022.

Dodgshon began his coaching career as head coach for the Fredericton District Soccer Association U-15 and U-17 Boys programs (2018-20), where he focused on youth development and long-term player growth. A native of Liverpool, England, Dodgshon holds a Master of Sport Science from the University of New Brunswick (Canada) and a Master of Chemistry from the University of St. Andrews (Scotland).



#### GOALKEEPING COACH GUILLERMO "MEMO" VALENCIA

Guillermo "Memo" Valencia will begin his ninth season with the Timbers after joining the coaching staff in 2018. Valencia came to Portland after spending five seasons as the goalkeeper coach for the New York Cosmos, helping the team win three NASL Soccer Bowl championships.

Valencia, who holds a USSF goalkeeping and "A" licenses, has coached goalkeepers for the U.S. Men's National Team between the U-17 and U-23 levels since 2009. During his 11-year professional playing career as a goalkeeper in Colombia, Valencia played for America de Cali (1990-1995) and Deportivo Pereira (1995-2001), featuring as a key member of the Pereira side that won the Professional Colombian Soccer Association league championship. Valencia later moved to the United States to compete for the Westchester Flames and the Long Island Rough Riders.

### TIMBERS VS. COLORADO HISTORY

The Portland Timbers kickoff their 16th season in MLS on Saturday, Feb. 21, against the Columbus Crew at Providence Park.

The Timbers and Crew have met in a season opener before, facing each other to open the 2016 season on March 6, 2016, a match Portland won 2-1. Notably, it marked the first match between the two sides since the 2015 MLS Cup Final in Columbus on Dec. 6, 2015 – a match Portland also won 2-1.

In total, Portland and Columbus have faced-off 14 times in MLS (including playoffs). The Timbers hold the head-to-head series advantage at 7-3-4. Portland has outscored the Crew 22-18 in their matchups, with the biggest margin of victory coming on April 20, 2019, via a 3-1 win in Columbus.

### SEASON OPENERS

The Timbers are set to open their MLS season at Providence Park for the fifth year in a row, dating back to the 2022 season. In that span, Portland has a 2-1-1 record in the season openers, outscoring opponents 8-7.

Dating back to their inaugural MLS campaign in 2011, the Timbers have posted a record of 5-5-5, and have outscored opponents 28-26 in all season openers. When hosting the first match of the season, Portland is an impressive 5-2-4 at Providence Park and have outscored their opponents 23-17.

In all 15 home openers, the Timbers are 8-3-4, outscoring opponents 34-25.

This year's season opener will notably be the Timbers' 500th match in MLS, and 250th at Providence Park.

### TRANSACTION TRACKER

**February 9, 2026** - Timbers waive DP forward **Jonathan Rodríguez** and exercised a buyout of his contract. Rodríguez no longer occupies a Designated Player slot and his previous wages will not count against the club's 2026 salary budget.

**February 2, 2026** - Portland acquire midfielder **Cole Bassett** from Colorado Rapids in exchange for \$2.65 million, and may send up to an additional \$950,000 to Colorado if certain performance-based incentives are achieved. Rapids may also retain a percentage of a future trade/transfer if Bassett is traded/sold above a certain amount. Bassett will occupy a U22 Initiative slot in 2026 and is under contract through 2027.

**January 9, 2026** - Timbers acquire \$2 million from Inter Miami CF in exchange for midfielder **David Ayala**. Portland can receive up to \$150,000 if certain performance metrics are reached. Timbers retain a sell-on percentage should Ayala be transferred above a specified amount.

**January 7, 2026** - Portland sign Australian defender **Alex Bonetig** from A-League Men's Western Sydney Wanderers through the 2027-28 season with a club option for 2028-29.

**December 23, 2025** - Timbers re-sign free agent defender **Eric Miller** to a one-year deal through the 2026 season.

**December 22, 2025** - Portland signs free agent defender **Brandon Bye** through December 2027 with an option through June 2028.

**December 4, 2025** - Timbers re-sign goalkeeper **Hunter Sulte** to a multi-year contract through the 2027-28 season with a club option for 2028-29.

**November 15, 2025** - Portland exercise contract options in 2026 for **David Ayala**, **Diego Chara**, **Gage Guerra**, **Felipe Mora**, **Trey Muse**, **James Pantemis** and **Ian Smith**.

**November 15, 2025** - Timbers decline contract options for **Felipe Carballo**, **Cristhian Paredes** and **Matías Rojas**.

**November 15, 2025** - **Maxime Crépeau**, **Eric Miller**, **Hunter Sulte** and **Dario Zuparic** are out of contract with the Portland Timbers.

### PROVIDENCE PARK CENTENNIAL

Providence Park is celebrating 100 years this season. Home to the Portland Timbers for the past 50 years, the historic Goose Hollow-neighborhood stadium has a capacity of 25,218, the sixth largest capacity of soccer-specific stadiums in the country. Formerly named Jeld-Wen Field, PGE Park, Civic Stadium and originally Multnomah Stadium upon completion in 1926, Providence Park is currently the oldest soccer-specific stadium in Major League Soccer and fourth-oldest major league stadium in the United States.

To honor its history, the Timbers unveiled the 'Civic Stadium Kit' on Feb. 10. The 2026 community jersey is comprised of a bold yellow chassis accented with art deco arches in Halo Green and Silver Green, drawing from the stadium's original 1920s architecture. It features an intricate art deco pattern inspired by the venue's grand arches. Visual cues of the North End seating, paying tribute to the supporters can be seen in the design. The Civic Stadium Kit will make its on-field debut on Feb. 28, when Portland plays Colorado Rapids on the road.

In MLS play, the Timbers are 131-51-67 all-time at Providence Park, scoring 447 goals at their home stadium. Portland has won double-digit home games five times (2013, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2021), with its best season coming in 2016 in which the club finished 12-3-2 at home. Portland's best scoring season at home came in 2024, with 39 goals being scored in Goose Hollow. In the MLS Cup Playoffs, the Timbers are 6-2-6 at home. The most goals scored by Portland in a single postseason at the stadium is six, set in 2021. Providence Park has hosted the MLS All-Star Game (2014), a Western Conference Final (2021) and an MLS Cup Final (2021).

### 2026 SCHEDULE

#### Cascadia Cup Clashes

Portland aim for their seventh Cascadia Cup and hosts Vancouver on March 7, and travel to BC Place on April 4. Portland will travel to Lumen Field on July 16, following the league-wide FIFA World Cup break, and will host Seattle on August 1.

#### Contests with the Eastern Conference

Timbers set to face six Eastern Conference clubs: Columbus Crew (2/21), Atlanta United FC (8/19) and Charlotte FC (10/24) at home. CF Montréal (5/13), Inter Miami CF (5/17) and Chicago Fire FC (8/16) on the road.

#### Decision Day 2026

The final matchday of the MLS regular season with MLS Cup Playoffs implications on the line, will take place on Saturday, November 7. Portland will travel to Austin, Texas, to take on Austin FC at Q2 Stadium. All Western Conference Decision Day matches will kick off at 4 p.m. (Pacific).

### 2026 PRESEASON, PRES. BY OLD TRAPPER

The Timbers played in their fourth-straight Coachella Valley Invitational, going 1-1-1 in three matches at the Empire Polo Grounds in Indio, Calif., from Feb. 7-14. New singings Cole Bassett, Alex Bonetig and Brandon Bye made their competitive debuts for Portland at the tournament. Portland registered six goals at CVI from four different scorers: Felipe Mora – 2, Kristoffer Velde – 2, Antony – 1 and Gage Guerra – 1. Antony led the team in CVI goal contributions with three (1g, 2a). With their results, the Timbers improved their overall record at the invitational to 4-3-3, outscoring opponents 20-15.

### CHARA'S MILESTONES

Diego Chara's next start will mark 400 MLS regular season starts, he currently has the most starts (399) of any active field player. Chara is set to become the 9th player to reach the milestone in league history. Notably, he'll become the first player in MLS history to start 400 matches with one club. In his next appearance, he'll become the first player to compete in 16 seasons with one club in league history. The club's all-time leader in games played is 9th all-time in minutes played (35,820) in MLS history.
