### HEAD COACH JACK CASSIDY

Hired as the club's third head coach in MLS NEXT Pro on Jan. 28, 2026. Cassidy, 35, joins with nearly 15 years of coaching and development experience across four countries in Europe and the Middle East. Following stints in Sweden, the United Arab Emirates, the United Kingdom, and most recently Denmark, Cassidy holds a UEFA A License and is a candidate for a UEFA Pro License. Prior to joining T2, Cassidy served as the First Team Assistant Coach & Head of Individual Development at Aalborg BK of the Danish 1st Division (2024-25). In his year with Aalborg, Cassidy oversaw the planning and structure of the first team's training sessions, spearheaded all aspects of individual player development, and contributed to the team's match preparation.



### LAST MATCH

**PORTLAND, Ore.** - In their 2026 MLS NEXT Pro season opener, Timbers2 earned a 2-1 comeback win over San Jose Earthquakes II at Providence Park on March 1. San Jose scored early in the first half to take the lead, but new signing Daniel Cervantes equalized for T2 with a penalty-kick goal in the 66th minute. Newcomer Maximilian Kissel secured the victory for Portland with his game-winning goal in the 89th minute of the match.

### THE NEWEST ADDITIONS

#### INTERNATIONAL SIGNINGS

Feb. 23, 2026: Timbers2 signed Mexican-American forward **Daniel Cervantes**. The 22-year-old signs after spending the last five seasons in Mexico's developmental Liga de Expansión MX and Liga de Fuerzas Básicas. A product of Sacramento Republic FC's academy, Cervantes signed with Liga MX's Atlas F.C.'s U18's in July 2021. He would go on to make 57 appearances for Atlas' youth squads (U18, U20, and U23), scoring 23 goals. He joined C.D. Guadalajara in July 2024, integrating himself into the U23 squad and their Liga de Expansión MX affiliate, CD Tapatio. Cervantes registered nine goals in 36 appearances during his time with C.D. Guadalajara and CD Tapatio (2024-25). He signed with C.D. Irapuato in July 2025, making three league appearances.

T2 signed German forward **Maximilian Kissel**. The 23-year-old arrives after spending the last two college seasons at Vermont (2024-25). Drafted by Inter Miami CF with the 90th pick (third round) of the 2026 MLS SuperDraft, Kissel also has German lower division experience after starting his career at VfB Ginsheim (2021-22). At the Ginsheim-Gustavsburg based club he recorded 28 appearances in total across the first and second team with three goals and two assists. While at Vermont, he totaled 39 appearances (15 starts) with 16 goals and two assists in two years. Notably, in 2024 he helped the Catamounts to their first-ever National Championship, scoring game winning goals in the tournament quarterfinals and championship game. He earned 2024 NCAA Tournament Offensive Most Outstanding Player, NCAA All-Tournament Team, and America East All-Conference Second Team honors (2024). From 2022-23, Kissel registered 39 appearances and 36 goals with two assists for Bridgeport. With the Knights, he led the nation in scoring in 2023 with 23 goals across 20 games, earning Division 2 Conference Commissioners Association First-Team All-America honors and notably scoring a career-high five goals in a match against Caldwell on Nov. 6, 2023.

Portland sign South African defender **Calem Tommy**. The 22-year-old signs after spending the last four college seasons at NC State (2022-25). Drafted by Houston Dynamo FC with the 39th pick in the second round of the 2026 MLS SuperDraft, the South Africa native is a product of Ubuntu Academy in Cape Town. While at NC State he amassed 74 appearances (48 starts) with two goals and 12 assists to his name in four years. During his senior year in 2025 he started and played in all but one match for the Wolfpack, registering career-highs in starts (22) and assists (8). Notably, he provided an assist in three of NC State's final four matches of the 2025 NCAA Tournament, including against Washington in the national championship, suffering a 3-2 defeat in extra time and earned 2025 All-ACC Third Team honors.

Jan. 14, 2026: Timbers2 sign English defender **Connor Ferguson**. The 21-year-old arrives following a short spell with Guiseley AFC of England's Northern Premier League Premier

Division. He made nearly 80 appearances for Leeds United U-18s and U-21's between 2021 and 2025, notably helping the U-21s earn promotion to Premier League 2 in 2023-24 and securing the National League Cup title in 2024-25.

#### TRANSFERRED IN

Jan. 23, 2026: T2 signed forward **Benjamin Barjolo** from USL Championship side Orange County SC. The 18-year-old signs with Portland following a two-year spell at Orange County SC where he made 21 appearances across all competitions. Most recently, he completed a short-term loan at USL League One side Union Omaha where he recorded a goal in five appearances. An Atlanta United Academy product, Barjolo won MLS NEXT Cup in 2023 as a member of Atlanta's U16 squad.

#### 2026 MLS SUPERDRAFTEES

Feb. 9, 2026: T2 sign Timbers' 75th overall pick **Lucas Fernandez-Kim**. The 22-year-old played at Oregon State in 2025 and recorded 17 appearances (all starts) for the Beavers. He tallied two goals and four assists while earning All-WCC Second Team honors in his lone year in Corvallis. He previously registered 53 appearances (47 starts) and 10 goal contributions (2G, 8A) while playing collegiately with UC Davis from 2022-24. Most recently he was a member of the Portland Timbers 2026 preseason roster and saw minutes at the Coachella Valley Invitational, as well as in closed-door scrimmages against LA Galaxy and LAFC.

Jan. 28, 2026: Timbers2 sign 15th overall pick **Justin McLean**. The 21-year-old is a midfielder out of North Carolina State. He made 22 appearances in his lone season with the Wolfpack (2025), tallying three goals and five assists. Notably, he led NC State to the 2025 Men's College Cup final, where he tallied one assist in the match but ultimately fell 3-2 in extra time to Washington. The Atlanta, Georgia native previously played for Georgia State (2022-24), where he recorded 49 appearances, registering 12 goals and 11 assists for the Panthers.

T2 sign 45th overall pick **Colin Griffith**. The 21-year-old is a forward who played four years at University of Maryland (2022-25), making 46 appearances, recording nine goals and six assists. Notably, he earned an All-Big Ten Second Team selection in 2024. A native of Stroudsburg, Pennsylvania, he was named the 2021-22 U19 MLS NEXT MVP, and has represented the youth national teams of Barbados.

#### FREE AGENT PICK-UP

Jan. 28, 2026: Timbers2 sign undrafted goalkeeper **Samuel Joseph** after a first-team trial in Portland's 2026 preseason. In his senior year at Virginia Tech, Joseph made 16 appearances for the Hokies, tallying a record of 7-4-5 and seven shutouts. Prior to that, the six-foot-four goalkeeper played three seasons at UCLA (2022-24), where he logged a 9-4-4 record and six shutouts. Notably, in his 33 collegiate appearances, Joseph kept a save percentage of 0.74%.

### T2 OVERVIEW

Timbers2 enter their fifth MLS NEXT Pro season in 2026 and 12th year overall as a part of the Timbers organization. In their first four seasons of MLS NEXT Pro play (2022-25), T2 registered a combined record of 31-56-21. In USL regular season play (2015-2020), T2 finished with a combined record of 56-94-24. T2 qualified for the USL playoffs once in the 2018 season.

Jack Cassidy became the third head coach for Portland Timbers2 in their MLS NEXT Pro era after being announced on Jan. 28, 2026. Cassidy's staff consists of assistant coach Andres Flores, goalkeeping coach Steve Reese, performance specialist Ian Russi, athletic trainer Ethan Konoza and soccer operations manager Chris Stanton. Cassidy, 35, is set to make his T2 head coaching debut this Sunday against Quakes II at Providence Park.

Prior to Cassidy's appointment, Serge Dinkota (2024-25), Shannon Murray (2022-23), Cameron Knowles (2018-20), Andrew Gregor (2016-17) and Jay Vidovich (2015) all took the helm for the second team.

T2 returns to Providence Park in 2026, marking the fifth-straight MLS NEXT Pro season Timbers2 calls the historic Goose-Hollow neighborhood stadium home. All T2 home matches at Providence Park are free to attend. With a capacity of 25,218, Providence Park is the sixth largest soccer-specific stadium in the country by capacity. In 2026, the historic stadium is celebrating 100 years following its construction completion in 1926. Home to the Portland Timbers for the past 50 years, it's been formerly named Jeld-Wen Field, PGE Park, Civic Stadium and originally Multnomah Stadium upon its completion. Providence Park is currently the oldest soccer-specific stadium in Major League Soccer and fourth-oldest major league stadium in the United States. The downtown Portland venue has hosted many historic events and matches, such as the 1977 North American Soccer League Soccer Bowl – which marked Pelé's last official match, a USMNT World Cup qualifying match, 1999 and 2003 Women's World Cup group and knockout matches, the 2014 MLS All-Star Game and the 2021 MLS Cup Final.

### LAST SEASON RECAP

Timbers2 finished the 2025 regular season with four players having six or more goal contributions, and 14 different players recording at least one goal.

In his final season at the helm, Serge Dinkota led T2 to 38 points in the 2025 season, finishing in 10th place of the Western Conference with a mark of 10-12-6. 38 points in an MLS NEXT Pro season ties the club record set in 2024. Gage Guerra (11G, 4A) finished the season with a team-high 15 goal contributions, while Mataeo Bunbury finished with career highs of six goals and two assists. Goalkeeper Lukas Burns recorded four clean sheets in 23 appearances.

Gage Guerra was awarded the MLS NEXT Pro Player of Matchweek 7 after his hatrick carried Portland to a 3-2 victory over Ventura County. Guerra's hat trick came as T2's third in four MLS NEXT Pro seasons. Additionally, Timbers2 earned Team of the Matchweek honors in Week 10 after earning back-to-back wins against LAFC 2 (3-0) on May 14 and Tacoma Defiance (2-1) on May 18.

Timbers2 hosted their first-ever match outside Portland city limits on Aug. 4, 2025, hosting Real Monarchs at Civic Park in Eugene, Ore. T2 played in front of 1,251 fans, a season-high attendance for the club in 2025. Timbers2 partnered with Kidsports to host the match, donating \$2 of every ticket purchased to Kidsports to help support youth athletics in Eugene.

### FROM T2 TO MLS

On June 26, 2025, the Portland Timbers signed T2 forward Gage Guerra to a one-year MLS deal through the 2025 season with club options for the next three years (2026-28). Guerra, 23, earned a first-team contract after providing 15 goal contributions (11 goals, four assists) in 19 games (17 starts) for T2 last season. On Nov. 14, 2025, the Timbers exercised their 2026 club option for Guerra, keeping him in Green and Gold through at least 2026.

The 23-year-old has made 11 appearances for the first-team across all competitions, recording two goals and one assist. He made his MLS debut on June 28, 2025, coming on as a second-half substitute in a Timbers road match at Toronto FC. Guerra made his first-team debut in the Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup Round of 32 against Tacoma Defiance after joining the Timbers on a short-term loan on May 6, 2025. Notably, he provided the equalizing header just two minutes into his debut in the 81st minute, with Portland eventually finding a game-winner in the 93rd minute to advance to the Round of 16 of the tournament.

The Houston native was originally selected by the Timbers in the third round (No. 69 overall) of the 2024 MLS SuperDraft out of the University of Louisville. He made his T2 debut on March 15, 2025, coming on as a second-half substitute against Real Monarchs. Notably, Guerra opened his professional scoring account with a hatrick on the road against Ventura County FC on April 23, 2025, earning MLS NEXT Pro Player of Matchweek 7.

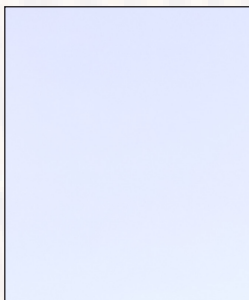

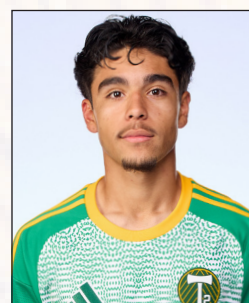
