### INTERIM HEAD COACH ANDRÉS FLORES

Andrés Flores was promoted to interim head coach on June 5, 2026, through the absence of current Timbers interim head coach Jack Cassidy. Flores, 35, enters his first head coaching role with over four years of experience as a Timbers2 assistant coach, and currently holds a National A-Senior Coaching License.

Prior to his time on the sidelines, Flores enjoyed a nearly 12 year professional playing career (2009-21). The former midfielder previously played for Portland in MLS, donning the Green and Gold in 45 appearances (23 starts) from 2018-20, and providing five goal contributions (2g, 3a).

Before his time with the Timbers, Flores was a decorated midfielder with the New York Cosmos (2014-17) where he won back-to-back NASL titles (2015, 2016) and was named the 2016 Hispanic Athlete of the Year in Nassau County, New York. Flores' first experience abroad came in 2012, spending the year in Denmark's second division with Viborg F.F., in-between stints with Asociación Deportiva Isidro Metapán (2009-11, 2013-14) in his native El Salvador.

A native of San Salvador, El Salvador, Andrés Flores represented La Selecta in 69 official matches, logging 3,748 international minutes.



### LAST MATCH

Portland Timbers2 (7-2-4, 26pts) extended its current road shutout winning streak to four games following a 1-0 victory at Vancouver Whitecaps FC 2 (2-10-2, 9pts) at Swangard Stadium in Burnaby, B.C., on June 5. T2 broke through in the 73rd minute via Daniel Cervantes' club-leading fourth goal of the season, and, Sam Joseph registered five saves on the evening en route to his fifth clean sheet this year to help secure the three points.

### TIMBERS2 NOTABLES

#### NOTES FROM LAST MATCH

##### **T2 1 at Whitecaps FC 2 0 - Swangard Stadium - June 5, 2026**

- Timbers2 (7-2-4, 26pts) are third in the Western Conference.
- It marked a fourth-straight road shutout for T2, registering over 360 minutes without conceding away from home.
- Portland has outscored opponents 6-0 over their last four road matches.
- Additionally, the win marked the second consecutive clean sheet overall.
- T2 has recorded seven total shutouts in 13 games played in 2026.
- Goalkeeper **Sam Joseph** recorded a team-leading fifth clean sheet in his eighth appearance (all starts).
- Forward **Daniel Cervantes'** tally vaulted him to top goalscorer for Portland this season with four goals.
- Both **Connor Ferguson** and **Lucas Fernandez-Kim** recorded their second assists of the season.
- **Ferguson** and **Fernandez-Kim** enter a four-way tie for club lead in assists (2) with **Eric Izoita** and **Sawyer Jura**.
- Additionally, **Fernandez-Kim** has delivered assists in back-to-back games.
- Notably, both **Ferguson** and **Fernandez-Kim** have registered two game-winning assists this season

#### RECENT STAFF CHANGES

Following the promotion of **Jack Cassidy** to the first team as interim head coach, Portland Timbers2 has undergone several staff adjustments ahead of this week's match. Assistant coach **Andrés Flores** will serve as interim head coach for T2 while **Cassidy** is with the first team. Additionally, goalkeeping coach **Steve Reese** has departed the organization, with a T2 goalkeeping coach to be announced. Despite the changes, T2 will maintain continuity in its technical approach during this stretch.

#### JOSEPH BETWEEN THE POSTS

**Sam Joseph** has climbed up the league standings following another stellar performance on June 5 at Vancouver. **Joseph**, 22, recorded his fifth clean sheet of the season against **Whitecaps FC 2**, registering five saves during the match. Notably, it marked **Joseph's** second shutout in a row, and third in his last five appearances. In eight matches this campaign, **Joseph** has a record of 6-1-1. **Joseph** is currently in a three-way tie for most clean sheets in the league (5) and has the second best save percentage in MLSNP at 82.1%.

#### T2 OVERVIEW

Timbers2 are in their fifth MLS NEXT Pro season in 2026 and 12th year overall as apart of the Timbers organization. In their first four seasons of MLS NEXT Pro play (2022-25), T2 registered a combined record of 31-56-21. In USL regular season play (2015-2020), T2 finished with a combined record of 56-94-24. T2 qualified for the USL playoffs once in the 2018 season.

**Andrés Flores** was promoted to interim head coach on June 5, 2026. **Flores** is filling in for former T2 head coach **Jack Cassidy**, who has been elevated to interim head coach of the first team while the search for a permanent head coach continues. **Flores** has been a T2 assistant coach for over four years, starting ahead of the 2022 season.

**Jack Cassidy** took the reins of Timbers2 ahead of their 2026 MLS NEXT Pro season as the third head coach in their MLSNP era, being announced on Jan. 28, 2026. Prior to his promotion to first team interim head coach, **Cassidy** entered the season with assistant coach **Andres Flores**, performance specialist **Ian Russi**, athletic trainer **Ethan Konoza** and soccer operations manager **Chris Stanton**. **Cassidy**, 35, made his T2 head coaching debut against **San Jose** in a 2-1 season opening victory at **Providence Park** on March 1.

Prior to **Cassidy's** appointment, **Serge Dinkota** (2024-25), **Shannon Murray** (2022-23), **Cameron Knowles** (2018-20), **Andrew Gregor** (2016-17) and **Jay Vidovich** (2015) all took the helm for the second team.

T2 returns to **Providence Park** in 2026, marking the fifth-straight MLS NEXT Pro season Timbers2 calls the historic **Goose-Hollow** neighborhood stadium home. All T2 home matches at **Providence Park** are free to attend. With a capacity of 25,218, **Providence Park** is the sixth largest soccer-specific stadium in the country by capacity.

In 2026, the historic stadium is celebrating 100 years following its construction completion in 1926. Home to the **Portland Timbers** for the past 50 years, it's been formerly named **Jeld-Wen Field**, **PGE Park**, **Civic Stadium** and originally **Multnomah Stadium** upon its completion. **Providence Park** is currently the oldest soccer-specific stadium in Major League Soccer and fourth-oldest major league stadium in the United States.

#### ROLLING ON THE ROAD

Matchday 14's 1-0 win against **Vancouver Whitecaps FC 2** marked the fourth-straight Timbers2 shutout on the road. T2 is 4-1 on the road this season having not dropped points while traveling since mid-march. Additionally, the team has managed to not concede a single goal on the road in that timeframe, while tacking on six of their own. Notably, T2 is tied in MLSNP for second longest win streak and holds the third-best away record in the entire league.

**Career:** Timbers2 signed goalkeeper Sam Joseph after going undrafted in MLS Super-Draft 2026. Joseph joined the Timbers as a trialist for their 2026 preseason.

In his senior season at Virginia Tech, Joseph made 16 appearances for the Hokies, tallying a record of 7-4-5 and seven shutouts. Prior to that, the six-foot-four goalkeeper played three seasons at UCLA (2022-24), where he logged a 9-4-4 record and six shutouts. Notably, in his 33 collegiate appearances, Joseph kept a save percentage of 0.74%.

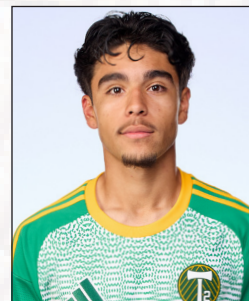
